


To preview applications in Foundant that are open to the Public or that require an Access Code

1. Click the Link provided to access the Public Apply page on Foundant, the Lehigh Valley Community Foundation's grants portal: <https://www.grantinterface.com/Process/Apply?urlkey=lehighvalley>.

The Public Apply page will display a list of public grant applications along with the grant application name, a summary of the grant information, and the dates in which we are accepting submissions.


For assistance finding a specific public grant application, utilize the Quick Search bar (circled in red below) and type in the grant name.

2022 - 2023 Entry to Program Stream - Pennsylvania Council on the Arts Accepting Submissions from 11/29/2021 to 02/15/2022

Entry to Program Stream is a new funding opportunity from the PA Council on the Arts (PCA) Partners in the Arts (PPA) that aims to provide valuable access to funding for small arts organizations and programs across Pennsylvania. Entry to Program Stream also serves as the access point for organizations and programs to begin a funding relationship with the PCA that could transition to Program Stream eligibility. The Lehigh Valley Community Foundation is the PPA for Region 5 which includes organizations in Carbon, Monroe, Lehigh and Northampton counties.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicants must be nonprofit, tax-exempt corporations, a unit of government, or a school district with a history of at least one year of consistent arts/cultural programming and/or arts services in Pennsylvania.
- Organizations can be a clearly defined arts program in a non-arts organization such as a college or university; library; social service organization; health care facility; YMCA; historical, science museum or other similar institution.
- Unincorporated groups (and in some instances, individuals) must apply to the PPA Program Stream through a nonprofit organization that acts as a fiscal sponsor.
- Applicant organizations must have an average annual revenue of less than \$200,000.

At this time, grant awards are projected to be \$2,000 per organization. This is subject to change.



3. To preview applications that require an Access Code, click the link provided to open the Public Apply page on Foundant, LVCF's grants portal:

Enter the Access Code into the search bar and click the 'Enter Code' button.
